

# INFUSION FUND REPORT

The Infusion Fund provides direct service assistance for survivors across Nebraska, covering all areas of our state, from rural to urban. The Fund provides the opportunity to pay for needed services in a variety of situations, which may include the following:

- The current need of the survivor is not covered through grant sources.
- Grant sources that would normally fund the need are exhausted.
- The expressed need is of a unique nature, requiring a special solution.

The Nebraska Coalition accepts requests for funding support from Coalition member programs, including Tribal programs. This includes situations where the member agency is working directly with the survivor they are requesting funds for, as well as situations where the survivor is being referred by a partner agency in the community and a funding request is funneled through the member program.

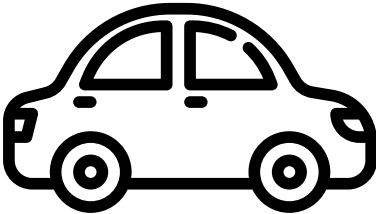

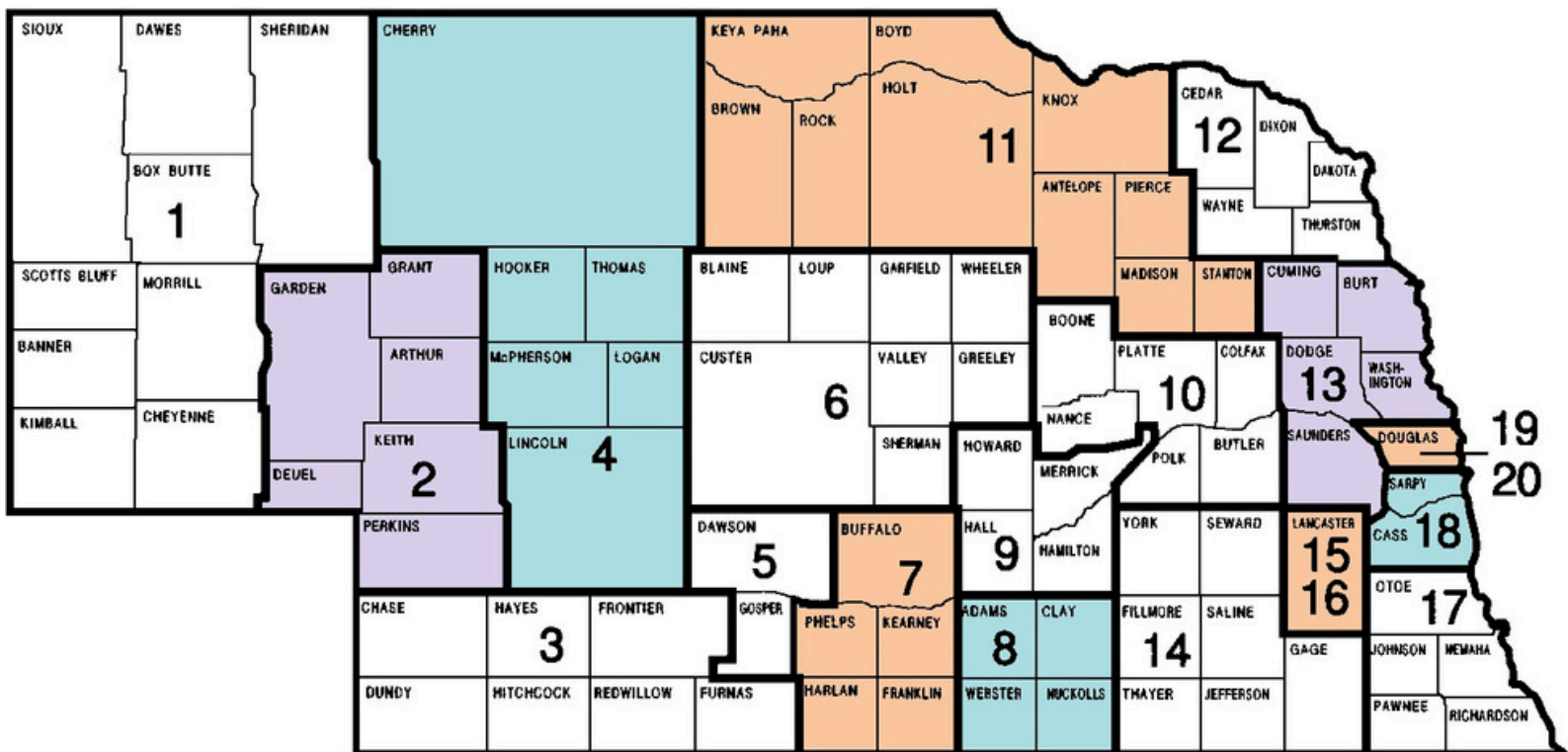

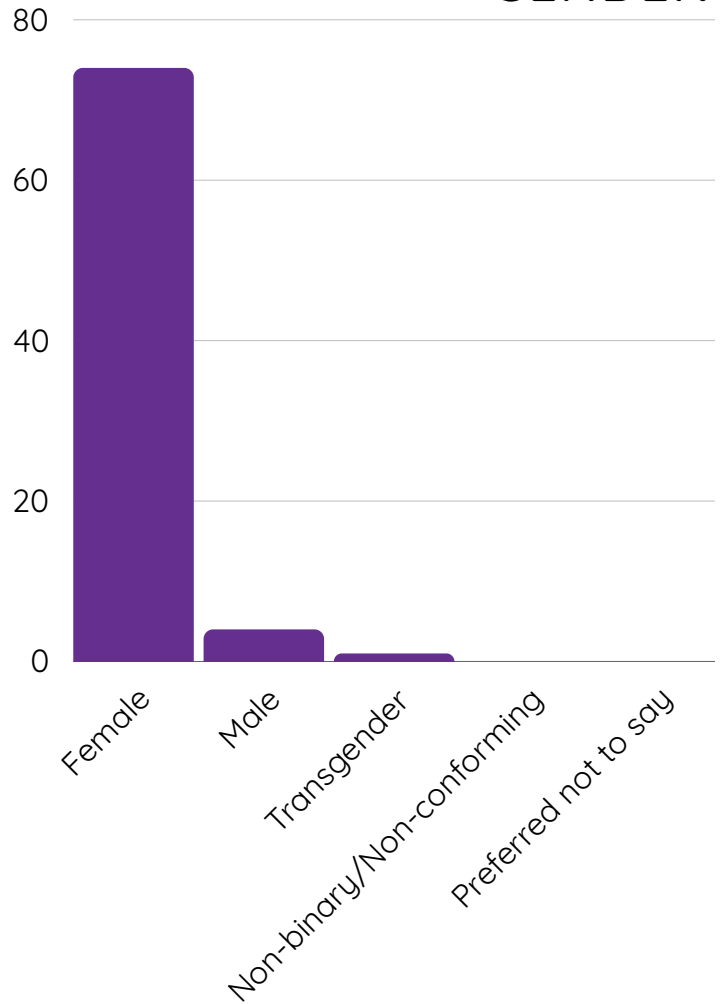


# Survivor Demographics
