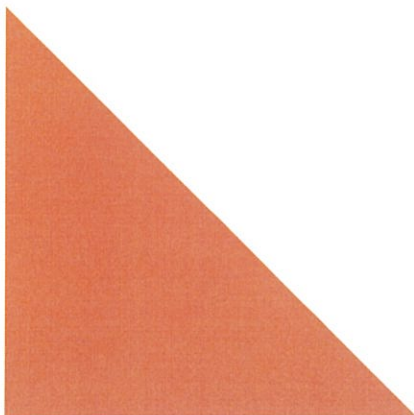
Infusion Fund

Support to Survivors in Nebraska

The Infusion Fund provides direct service assistance for survivors across Nebraska, covering all areas of our state, from rural to urban. The Fund provides the opportunity to pay for needed services in a variety of situations, which may include the following:

- The current need of the survivor is not covered through grant sources.
- Grant sources that would normally fund the need are exhausted.
- The expressed need is of a unique nature, requiring a special solution.

The Nebraska Coalition accepts requests for funding support from community agencies that provide assistance to survivors. The agency does not need to be within the direct membership of the Nebraska Coalition.

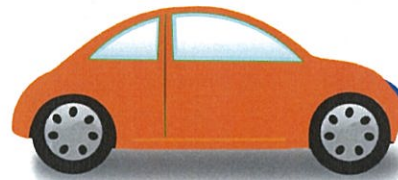


52 SURVIVORS

received support for rent, deposits, mortgage, home repairs, and hotel expenses totaling \$32,693.60.

18 SURVIVORS

benefited from aid toward transportation costs including car repairs, payments, insurance, registration, fuel, bus tickets, and driver's license renewals for a total of \$7,810.95.



14 SURVIVORS

obtained assistance with paying utility deposits, arrearages, and ongoing utility costs for a total of \$3,588.01.

13 SURVIVORS

requested assistance with miscellaneous expenses such as costs for medical, child care, pets, phone, bills, moving, and gifts for children for a total of \$4,307.44.



5 SURVIVORS

received assistance with legal representation and court filing fees for a total of \$1,600.00.
